illiteracy, poverty and misfortune and emerged as a real winner.

Leelaben was far away from the boon of Literacy right from her childhood; she got married to Damor Ramanbhai a farmer by profession and came to Dholkhakhra a small village in Panchmahal District. The Scenario was similar in this village where literacy was a remote possibility especially for women. She gave birth to a girl child and decided that she will not let her daughter suffer from the hardships that she



had suffered. She firmly announced to her family her decision to educate her daughter for her bright future.

Smt. Leelaben had an inner urge to study and break the barriers of illiteracy and false traditions of society Saakshar Bharat Programme provided her the opportunity to realize her dreams.



She joined Saakshar Bharat Programme and gradually acquired basic skills in Reading, writing & numeracy. Literacy boosted her self confidence and

empowered her to contest in Gram Panchayat elections as a result of which she got elected as Gram Pradhan of Dholkhakhra village.

Today she proudly resumes the post of Gram Pradhan and strives for the betterment and upliftment of the village especially the women folk in her village.
